- 1. ANNOUNCEMENT.** The Sunbeam Motor Cycle Club LTD: will organize the 16th Annual Conyboro Run on Sunday 25th May 2008 at The Six Bells, Chiddingly, East Sussex.
The event will be open to any persons entering a motorcycle, sidecar outfit or tricycle manufactured prior to 31st December 1939, {machines in the Post Vintage Class Must Have Girder Forks} The event will be held under these instructions and any final instructions.
- 2. ENTRIES.** These will be accepted only if submitted on the official entry form, accompanied by **The entry fee of £7.00p** if a member of the SMCC LTD, or entry fee for non-members will be £10.00p, any passengers will pay the ACU insurance fee of £1.50p.
Entries to reach the Secretary of the Meeting by no later than Thursday 15th May 2008. Machines must comply with all legal requirements and display a current Road Fund Licence. Entry fees will only be refunded if the event is cancelled.
- 3. DESCRIPTION.** Entrants are required to assemble at The Six Bells, Chiddingly, East Sussex, By 1030 hrs on Sunday 20th May 2007. There will be a Road Safety Run starting at 1100hrs.

ROUTE A: Will be of 50 miles through the Weald, in a sporting mode.

ROUTE B: Will be of 30 miles in a gentle mode, for veteran and lower powered machines.

The Choice of Route will be that of the Rider.

An afternoon route will be available for any riders wishing to go out after lunch.

Participation in the runs is voluntary, but to qualify for an award, entrants will be required to complete one of the set routes, in accordance with these regulations and any final instructions.

Machines will be judged by the competitors who will be issued with a voting paper at the sign on tent.
